Leveraging the AI "Airskoi," which has learned from over 50,000 kois entries in previous competitions, we have made it possible to conduct the show online. We aim to bring together koi enthusiasts, producers, and industry professionals from around the world to showcase the results of their breeding efforts. This event provides an opportunity for more people to easily participate in koi shows. Through this event, our goal is to expand the community of koi enthusiasts and promote international goodwill.

As indicated below, we will be hosting the world's first koi show using the "Airskoi" AI app.

1.4. Entry process: ①Capture a video using the "Airskoi" app.②Detect the best shot image extracted from the video within the app.③Submit the entry using the best shot image.


■Creating Best Shot Images:



Shooting
Items

1. Best Shot Image (Required)
2. Size-Indicating Photo (Required)
3. Overall Frontal and Side Views, and a Video of Various Parts of the Koi from the Front and Sides (30-60 seconds)



■Points to note of Best Shot

- Ensure the body is straight.
- · Keep the mouth closed.
- · Spread the fins.
- Close the gill covers.
- Capture with the color palette simultaneously (recommended).
- Ensure even lighting without shadows on parts of the koi or color palette..



Shooting Examples

1.5. Judging Method and Prize Determination:

- Conduct initial judging through AI, selecting the top 3 koi from each category.
- The koi linked to the top 3 positions by the AI undergo a final video check by the judging team.
- **1.6.** Entry Fee: \(\frac{\pmathbf{3}}{3}\),000 per entry (regardless of size).
- **1.7. Entry Fee Payment Methods:** "In-App Payment" or "PayPal".


3.1. Application and Submission Period:


