We are pleased to announce a global online koi show that you can easily join from the comfort of your home with just a smartphone. The event is scheduled for February 15, 2024, at the 香港九龍公園(The 16th Asia Cup Koi Show, same time. @Kowloon Park, Tsim Sha Tsui, Kowloon, Hong Kong). Leveraging the AI "Airskoi," which has learned from over 50,000 kois entries in previous competitions, we have made it possible to conduct the show online. We aim to bring together koi enthusiasts, producers, and industry professionals from around the world to showcase the results of their breeding efforts. This event provides an opportunity for more people to easily participate in koi shows. Through this event, our goal is to expand the community of koi enthusiasts and promote international goodwill.

As indicated below, we will be hosting the world's first koi show using the "Airskoi" AI app.

1. Event details

- Qualification of Exhibitors: Koi Hobbyists, Dealers and Breeders from all over the world
- Qualification of Koi: For koi from all over the world.
 *We kindly request that koi that have received Grand Champion or higher awards at the All Japan Koi Show not be submitted.

■ Categories for entered Koi: : <u>Kohaku · Taisho-sanshoku · Showa-sanshoku</u>, 20BU to Over 90BU, 6 divisions, 9 parts.

- Entry Fee Payment Methods:
 - "In-App Payment"
- Application and Entry Period

From December 26, 2024, 00:00 (Japan Time) to February 7, 2025, 24:00 (Japan Time).

- Judging Method and Prize Determination:
 - ① Conduct basic evaluations using AI to select the top koi in each category.

 Perform a final video check of "defect-related criteria" on the koi linked as top candidates by AI, conducted by a panel of judges (including executives from the All Japan Nishikigoi Promotion Association).

[Defect-Related Criteria]

- 1. Fins (Pectoral, Dorsal, Caudal): Fractured bones or visible damage
- 2. Mouth: Crooked or unable to close
- 3. Eyes: Missing one eye
- 4. Head: Noticeably crooked
- 5. Gills: Unable to close or visibly damaged

- 6. Body: S-shaped curvature
- 7. Skin: Visible wounds on the skin or red pattern areas
- 2 Finalize the rankings.

■ Awards:

Overall Grand Champion of the Tournament: 3 awards (1 winner for each of the 3 varieties)

Gold Award for Each Category: 18 awards (6 categories × 3 varieties) Silver Award for Each Category: 18 awards (6 categories × 3 varieties) Bronze Award for Each Category: 18 awards (6 categories × 3 varieties)

Award certificates will be presented as digital data.

1. Install the "Airskoi" App


How to enter the Koi show in the Airskoi APP

- 2. Register Your Koi in "My Koi": Use the "My Koi" section within the Airskoi app to register the koi you wish to submit. Photos and videos taken with a camera or smartphone can be uploaded for registration and submission.
 - Note: Edited photos are not allowed. Submitting edited photos may result in disqualification, and submission fees will not be refunded.
- 3. Input Details: Enter details such as the koi's nickname, variety, and other relevant information.
- 4. Save and Proceed to Shooting: Save the information and proceed to capture the required images and videos
- 5. Required Media: Capture the following, ① Front Photo: Take a photo from the front view, ② Measurement Photo: Take a photo showing the koi's size, ③ Video (Free Shooting): Record a video of approximately 30 seconds.
- 6. Select the Koi Show: After registration, go to the "Koi Show" section and select "The 3rd AI Online World Koi Show."
- 7. Entry Koi Information: Click the "Entry" button and input the koi's variety, size, and other details.
- 8. Upload Photos and Video: Upload the captured photos and video.
- 9. Complete Entry: Select "Entry," make the payment, and complete the submission process.

- Ensure the body is straight.
- · Keep the mouth closed.
- · Spread the fins.
- · Close the gill covers.
